- French Cross Country Championship (Drivers and co-drivers)
- Trophy Cross Country racing 4x4 (Drivers and co-drivers)
- Challenge 2 wheels drive (Drivers and co-drivers)
- Challenge SSV (Drivers and co-drivers)

# 1.3P. ADMINISTRATIVE CHECKS

Administrative checks will be held on April 24th from 8.30 to 12.30am and from 2.00 to 5.30pm and on April 25th from 8.30 to 12.30 am.

Location : Café de l'UNION – CORBEILLES en GÂTINAIS.

They will take place exclusively when collecting the roadbook.

Documents to be provided: driver's and co-driver's sporting licenses and driving licenses.

Technical inspection will be held on April 25th from 4.30 to 7pm

Location: CORBEILLES en GÂTINAIS, on the market place on church place.

The convocation times schedules, **which must be imperatively respected**, at the TC C for entry to the technical checks will be posted on the rally website on the Monday preceding before the event.

Do not forget to fill in the safety equipment registration form to be given to the scrutineers.

After technical checks, crews must drive their vehicle directly to the "Parc Fermé" located at « LA SUCRERIE » in CORBEILLES en GÂTINAIS

**Unloading and reloading of the vehicles should only be made** in the dedicated park of « LA SUCRERIE » in CORBEILLES en GÂTINAIS (in front of the Service Park).

#### 3.1.12P.

The Entry Form will be <u>accepted</u> only if accompanied by the above entry fees (Except for foreign competitors paying in cash).

Applications for entries must be **COMPLETELY fulfilled**. Failure to do so will result in the cancellation of the entry.

Any Entry form made by e-mail will be definitively taken into account only if confirmed by post mail accompanied by the payment of the amount of the entry fees.

In the case of a waiting list, full applications accompanied by the entry fees will be taken as a priority (add the bank informations to the entry).

The entry fees will be banked after the checks.

Entry fees paid <u>by cheque</u> with insufficient founding will systematically be object of a sanction <u>requested to</u> the French Federation FFSA (<u>according to</u> article 3.10 of the International Sport Code).

ASA Loiret will bank the entry fees from the crews who are in possession of their road-book, and are not at the start of the event.

#### 4.3P. SERVICE

In accordance with the FFSA standard regulations.

Service is forbidden outside the locations provided for this purpose.

The Service teams will be required to **CLEAN THEIR LOCATION of ALL TRACES OF MUD** left after each intervention on the racing vehicles.

ONLY ONE Service vehicle per racing vehicle, will be allowed in the assistance parks, with the mandatory "ASSISTANCE" sticker on the top right of the windshield. Otherwise, penalties of 30 seconds and 200 € will be applied.

# **ARTICLE 5P. CAR IDENTIFICATION AND PUBLICITY**

#### **5.1P. CAR IDENTIFICATION**

In accordance with the standard FFSA rally regulations and to the FFSA Cross-Country french championship regulations.

#### **5.2P. PUBLICITY**

Compulsory and optional advertising shall be communicated by a bulletin to this Supplementary Regulation.

The compulsory advertising of **AGORA TT** shall be affixed on the place of the front registration plate of the vehicles, and **shall be visible**, in accordance with Article 4.6.1 of the standard Cross-Country Rally Regulations, subject to the sanctions provided for in Article 5.4 of the same Regulation: Penalty of € 160 for the first report and a penalty of € 320 for a second offense.

# **ARTICLE 6P. LOCATIONS AND INFRASTRUCTURES**

In accordance with the FFSA Rallies standard regulations.

#### **6.1P. DESCRIPTION**

The 19th Cross-Country Rally TERRES DU GÂTINAIS represents a total distance of 290 km.

It is divided in 2 legs and 6 sections including 12 special stages (or ES) with a total length of 150 km.

#### 6.2P. RECCEES

In accordance with the regulations of the French Cross-Country Rallies Championship.

# Reccees are allowed on:

Thursday April 24th from 8.30 am to 6.30 pm Friday April 25th from 8.30 am to 4.00 pm

Low speed as roads/trails are open to all traffic. It is forbidden to make reccees in opposite direction.

Competitors must wear wristbands handed over by the organization and stickers on motorcycles / quads. Failure to do so by crews will be penalised by a refusal of start as provided by article 6.2 of the standard FFSA rally regulations.

A reccee convoy <u>may</u> be organized ONLY if the conditions of the <u>weather conditions</u> allow it and at the Organizer choice.

<u>Departure</u> on Friday April 25th at 9.00 am from parking trucks of the sugar factory of CORBEILLES EN GÂTINAIS. Adapted tires are mandatory.

Only drivers and co-drivers are allowed.

# **ARTICLE 7P. RUNNING OF THE RALLYE**

In accordance with the regulations of the French championship of Cross-Country Rallies

#### 7.1.8P

Road books are available at the beginning of the <u>reccees</u>, as well as the 2 wrist bracelets for drivers and co-drivers and two stickers per vehicle to be posted on the <u>reccees</u> vehicles.

Distinctive signs for marshals are: orange bibs or overall with function badge

#### 7.5.1P. REMINDER OF THE SPECIFIC RALLY RULES

#### In accordance with the Art. 7.5.1 of the French Cross-Country Rallies championship regulations

The competitors are informed that the inside of turns and changes of direction as well as the exteriors of the chicanes will be protected and materialized to avoid crossing the limits of the race track. Any contact with these materials or their crossing will be considered as a non-respect of the race route.

#### 7.6P. PARC FERME

In addition to the general rules governing rallies, in a Parc fermé at the end of the legs, cars without a watertight door (Net) or SSV cars are allowed to put a cover on the car to protect it from possible bad weather conditions.

CAUTION in the absence Bank details in the entry form, the prices will not be distributed to the competitor.

# **LEGEND GROUP PRIZE MONEY:**

The organizer creates a special category called LEGEND GROUP outside the title recognized by the FFSA.

These T1A and T1B vehicles must meet the following criteria:

- Chassis built up to 2004 (date of creation of the technical passport)
- Year of origin of the "manufacturer" part number of the engine until 2004

- H-shaped or sequential gearbox depending on the vehicle's original equipment
- Cantilevered or central motor depending on the original layout
- Free shock absorbers

The competitor must specify on the entry form his/her candidacy in this category by committing to be technically compliant, which can be verified by the organizer.

#### 10.2P. TROPHIES

- 2 trophy cups to the top 3 of the championship group (T1A/T3 combined),
- 2 trophy cups to the first 3 of the 4X4 Trophy (T2, T2B and T2B + combined),
- 2 trophy cups to the first 3 of the 2WD Challenge (T1B),
- 2 trophy cups to the first 3 of the Challenge SSV rally,
- 2 cups to each other crew that finishes classified
- 2 marshals trophy cups (2 beneficiaries drawn by lot).

Nota: Trophy cups not taken during the Price giving ceremony will be lost if the crew do not attend to it.
